

Health and safety protocol

Your stay at the Paul Langevin Centre 2021

Updated 9th August 2021



You will need to present a valid HEALTH PASS on arrival at the centre.
Masks must be worn in all communal areas.

Your safety and wellbeing remains our highest priority. Please see below the extra measures we have introduced to help keep you safe and allow you to fully enjoy your stay with us.

OUR ON-SITE STAFF



- Comprehensive staff safety and hygiene training.
- Designated health and safety director on site, Stéphane BOYER.
- We have limited the maximum capacity of the center to 160 people (65%).

- Protective screens
- Team members with personal protective equipment
- Signs with information about social distancing and sanitizing stations.
- Increased cleaning and disinfection especially of all high touch areas.
- Regular disinfection of reception desk and materials such as room keys. Etc
- Masks and hand sanitiser gel on sale
- **Rooms are available from 14h on the day of arrival**



IN THE ROOMS

- Increased aeration in the rooms after every departure (**rooms must be vacated by 09h00**)
- Strengthened room cleaning protocols including extra disinfection of all high touch and bathroom areas.
- All linens washed at high temperatures.



BAR

- Protective screens and staff wearing masks.
- Clients are required to wear masks for ordering at the bar.
- No drinking at the bar only at the tables
- Strengthened cleaning and disinfection.
- All glasses and cups cleaned at + 60°
- Tables spaced safely apart to respect social distancing.
- Floor markings to indicate the direction of movement.
- Contactless payment offered.
- During the coffee breaks, drinks will be served by the barista with individual portions



CIRCULATION

- Use of lifts is limited to 1 person at a time with a preference to use the ramps and stairs where possible
- Communal areas regularly cleaned and disinfected throughout the day (07h00-19h00) paying special attention to high touch areas
- In certain areas there are floor markings to indicate the direction of circulation
- Special attention to the organisation of the movement of the groups to limit the mixing of people, where possible



RESTAURANT

- Tables spaced safely apart to respect social distances.
- Floor markings to respect social distancing
- Regular cleaning and disinfection paying attention to high touch points.
- Staff wearing personal protection equipment.
- Food is served at the table or in buffet respecting strict food safety procedures
- Masks must be worn for moving around the dining room
- Possibility to reserve a table for a group for the duration of the stay



COMMUNAL AREAS

- Mask have to been worn in all communal areas
- Implemented physical distancing measures throughout the centre.
- Strengthened cleaning protocols including extra disinfection of all areas with special attention to high touch areas.
- We ask you to use the bathroom in your rooms as much as possible
- Extra cleaning and disinfection of the public restrooms

CONFERENCE ROOMS

- Before entering, hand washing is compulsory with a preference of soap and water or the gel available at the entrance
- Please use every other seat, offset from the front and rear rows when possible.
- Masks must be worn
- One chair per table where applicable, placed in offset rows when
- It is recommended to keep the same place during the whole stay.
- Respect the signs indicating the direction of movement.
- Reinforced disinfection and cleaning of rooms, particularly on surfaces and points of contact: tables, shelves, seats, switches, handles, etc.
- Frequent airing.



Baby foot, ping pong and the piano room are available with certain hygiene guidelines to be followed as are the television and fitness rooms.

Our protocol adheres to local and national laws. If required please ask for specific protocols for each individual service.
